# JABUNG BLOCK DEVELOPMENT

The Jabung Working Area spans 1,643 square kilometers in West Tanjung Jabung and East Tanjung Jabung regencies, Jambi province.

PetroChina International Jabung Ltd. (PCJL) has operated Jabung since 2002, under the monitoring and supervision of Indonesia's upstream oil and gas regulator SKK Migas.





PCJL has gained various recognitions for its good performance in managing Jabung, which is currently one of Indonesia's top ten oil and gas blocks. In February 2023, the Indonesian government granted PCJL a contract extension to continue managing Jabung for the period of 2023-2043.

In this new period, PCJL manages Jabung in strategic partnership with PT Pertamina Hulu Energi Jabung, PETRONAS Carigali (Jabung) Ltd., PT GPI Jabung Indonesia and PT Raharja Energi Tanjung Jabung.







In 2024, PCJL secured Green
PROPER for gas operation in Betara
area and oil operation in Geragai.
Previously, the company has received
numerous health and safety awards,
including the Patra Nirbhaya Karya
Utama Adinugraha I, Subroto Awards
and SKK Migas Health Safety and


### **EDUCATION**
